## **The Studio**

**Circus:** Run off and join the circus this summer in Putney! This class combines clowning, games, and basic circus skills including juggling, peacock feather balancing, and balance pipe walking. Come play with us! (Ages 6-10) Instructor: Cara Trezise

**Costumes and Clothing:** An introduction to costume design and sewing. We will choose fabrics, learn to use patterns, and put together clothing and accessories. We will work with fabric, pins, needles and thread, and the sewing machine. (Ages 9-12) Instructor: Joan Peters

**Clay:** Whether you are an advanced or beginning clay practitioner you will make amazing works of art. From bowls to beads to animals and even small tables we will fill the world with clay creations. We will use slab, coil, and covered armature techniques. (Ages 6-12) Instructor: William Chambers

**Drama:** This class is a foundation for stage performance and character development. Students will practice how to use their bodies to express emotion, develop and define characters, and create scenes. They will develop and perform comedy sketches to be shared with families. (Ages 6-12) Instructor: Amelia Struthers

**Found Sound:** Searching for music in unlikely places. Using junk and discarded materials each student will build a unique instrument and then learn how to play it. A final performance will show our progress and innovation. (Ages 9-12) Instructor: Cara Trezise

**Garden Arts:** Come paint, weave, and build in our new garden. If you would like to talk to the plants, build an arch, construct a hidden resting spot, and create your own unique hand painted signs, then this is the place for you. Or maybe you would like to join us while we sit in the shade, drink sun tea, and watch the sunflowers dance. (Ages 6-12) Instructor: Collin Leach

**Mask Making:** Construct wearable and totem masks from recycled, found materials. They will use these colorful designs, based on the many mask making cultures of the world, to perform a ceremonial procession on the last day of class. (Ages 6-10) Instructor: Art Costa

**Painting, Drawing, and Collage:** Come paint, draw, and collage. We will use pencils, crayons, brushes, pastels, acrylics, tempera paint, and watercolors. We will collage using mixed media, fabric, recycled, and found materials. Bring your imagination. (Ages 6-12) Instructor: Joan Peters

### The Studio

**Printmaking:** We will explore two exciting techniques; monotype and relief printing. Colorful, one-of-a-kind monoprints will be created using inks, brayers, oil sticks, and stencils. We will also create an edition of relief prints using easy-cut rubber blocks. (Ages 9-12) Instructor: Kim Hartman Colligan

### Nature Explorations

**Animals, Fire and other Mysteries:** We will tell stories each day, pretend to be animals, wander and explore, lift stones, find feathers and bones, sit by the fire and snack, play hiding games, climb, play, get muddy, and create all sorts of fun things out of sticks. (Ages 6-9) Instructor: Amy Hyatt of the Vermont Wilderness School

**Survival Adventures:** Learn to be invisible, how to sneak up and touch animals, and how to move in silence. Make fire by rubbing sticks together, carve safely with knives, cook lunch over a fire that you make yourself, and track animals to their dens to see what they have been eating. (Ages 9-12) Instructor: Amy Hyatt of the Vermont Wilderness School

### Athletic Adventures

**High and Low Ropes Course:** This is a challenge course program, which will include games, initiatives, low, and high ropes. The emphasis is toward group dynamics, trust, cooperation, and self-confidence. (Ages 8-12) Instructors: Chris Harlow or Hop Hopkins

**Archery:** This is a basic class in technique and equipment instruction. We will be practicing in controlled settings using hay bale targets. Emphasis will be on safety, fun and skills. Instructor: Chris Harlow (Ages 9-12) Instructors: Chris Harlow

**Pool and Recreational:** From 1:30 to 3:30. This is an adult-supervised program of games, swimming, and other fun activities. This class includes snack and admission to the Putney Pool. (Ages 6-12) Instructor: Tammy White
