Balloonigami: Dinosaur Sculptures! We will use balloons and cut paper to create papier mache dinosaurs. Let your imagination run free. It is a messy business so dress appropriately. (Ages 7-12) Instructor: John Gurney

Batik: Beautiful batik! In this workshop we'll practice the art of batik, a traditional fabric craft from Africa and India. Use wax-resist to dye and create colorful designs and make your very own T-shirt, pillow, and more. (Ages 6-12) Instructor: Linda Whelihan

Cartooning and Illustration: Every picture tells a story. Create expressive cartoon characters. Draw expressive faces and use pictures to tell a story. Have fun drawing silly pictures, murals, and engage in cartooning activities. (Ages 9-12) Instructor: John Gurney

Design Build: creative constructions in motion: In this session you will learn to use a variety of building techniques and materials to design and create constructions that are in motion. Invent things that balance, float, fly, roll, or spin. (Ages 7-12) Instructors: Linda Kosiba & William Chambers

Digital Art: Students will explore digital photography. Working with *Adobe Photoshop* we will transform our images into works of art and works of fun. We will explore filters, painting and drawing on images, and repeating patterns. Enter the digital realm. (Ages 9-12) Instructor: William Chambers

Garden Arts: Come paint, weave, and build in our new garden. If you would like to talk to the plants, build an arch, construct a hidden resting spot, and create your own unique hand painted signs, then this is the place for you. Or maybe you would like to join us while we sit in the shade, drink sun tea, and watch the sunflowers dance. (Ages 6-12) Instructor: Collin Leach

Painting, Drawing, and Collage: We will explore various painting media including: watercolor, tempera, and acrylic. We'll paint from life, from the imagination, and from art history. We will practice sketching as well as drawing with crayons and pastels and use collage to make mixed media pieces. (Ages 6-12) Instructor: Jeanette Staley

Wearable Art: Recycled wonders. Out of the trash will come the treasures. We'll use different sculpting techniques to turn materials headed for the landfill into practical items as well as works of art. An inner-tube wallet? Bottle-cap jewelry? Bring your imagination and we'll discover the possibilities. (Ages 9-12) Instructor: Linda Whelihan

Weaving: Weaving is easy to learn and open to creative expression! Discover a world of patterns while weaving belts or lanyards on an inkle loom. Explore the textures of yarns while weaving wall hangings or pillow covers on a tapestry loom. Using traditional and contemporary forms, along with color and design principles, we will create beautiful handwoven pieces to wear and display. (Ages 6-9) Instructor: Shana Frank

Nature Explorations

Animals, Forest and other Mysteries: We will tell stories each day, pretend to be animals, wander and explore, lift stones, find feathers and bones, sit by the fire and snack, play hiding games, climb, play, get muddy, and create fun things out of sticks. (Ages 6-9) Instructor: Amy Hyatt of The Wilderness School

Survival Adventures: Learn to be invisible, how to sneak up and touch animals, and how to move in silence. Make fire by rubbing sticks together, carve safely with knives, cook lunch over a fire that you make yourself, and track animals to their dens to see what they have been eating. (Ages 9-12) Instructor: Amy Hyatt of the Wilderness School

Athletic Adventures

Co-ed Soccer: A chance to improve game skills while having a positive learning experience. Each class will begin with warm-up and skill building drills and include time for fun-filled scrimmages. (Ages 7-11) Instructor: Jamie Dansereau

Pool and Recreational: From 1:30 to 3:30. This is an adult-supervised program of games, swimming, and other fun activities. This class includes snack and admission to the Putney Pool. (Ages 6-12) Instructor: Tammy White

Skate Boarding: Introduction to board riding skills, safety precautions, cool moves, small ramps, and elements. Try your hand at building ramps and boxes. Get shredder style and skatepark etiquette. All skill levels welcome. *Equipment provided with advance notice (\$10 rental fee).* (Ages 7-12) Instructor: Barry Lane
