**Colorful Creations** (Mornings 9:00 – 1:30) **First Session** (June 21 to June 25)

Come and explore the fun and magic of art! We will experiment with many media including different paints, clay and markers and let our imaginations carry us away. We will see what happens when we mix different colors and use tools and brushes. The results will include large and small paintings, colorful collages, handmade beads and a papier mache volcano that really erupts!

**Oceans Ahoy!** (Mornings 9:00 – 1:30) **Second Session** (June 28 to July 2)

Pirates and Mermaids will be welcome (Costumes from home are encouraged and more dress-ups will be provided at camp.) Plenty of mermaid and pirate stories and dramatic play are in store, on top of map drawing and treasure hunts. We will also make boats and test them in the TGS pond, craft seashell jewelry and decorate treasure boxes. Hot afternoons will be spent running through the sprinkler!

**Magical Fantasy** (Mornings 9:00 – 1:30) **Third Session** (July 5 to July 9)

If you love fairies and magic, then you will love “Magical Fantasy.” We will look for signs of fairies and gnomes, build fairy houses and dioramas, and see if any magical creatures spend the night in them! There will be plenty of time for dress up, puppet shows, stories, treasure hunts, and unicorn collages. We will also hunt for bug and butterfly friends.

**Ready, Set, Play!** (Mornings 9:00 – 1:30) **Fourth Session** July 12 to July 16)

“Ready, Set, Play!” will include movement-based games, dramatic play, and story telling. We will have lots of fun dressing up, making sounds and music, and using fun props in our active play. We will also learn some calming yoga poses, make masks, and do plenty of painting and drawing.
